HANDS-ON SESSION DESCRIPTIONS

ROOM H107 – Advanced A & B and Basic A & B: Looking Through the Window: Does a Brown Cow Give Chocolate Milk? How you care for your animal, what you say in the barn, and how you answer questions can have a real impact on agriculture. Class will focus on Animal Welfare, Public Perception and How We Represent Agriculture.

ROOM H116– Advanced A & Basic A: What Do You Really See?: Do you really look at your animal everyday while you are in the barn? Class focuses on the importance of animal observation.

ROOM H116: Advanced B – Volunteer Training: Required training for all volunteers. This class will count as a session for parents who are attending Quality Assurance with your child. If you have any questions regarding this session, please contact the Extension Office at 330-533-5538.

ROOM H108: Basic A & B: First Year QA?: Highly Recommended for First Year Members! First Year members always have questions. This class will help provide pointers & suggestions on making you first year a good experience and stress the importance of the current GPP's along with ethics & animal welfare.

ROOM P108: Advanced A & B: Quality Assurance Jeopardy: Class will answer various Quality Assurance questions based on the GPP's we are discussing and GPP 10. Class will interact by answering the questions. Discussion or explanation may follow. Points will be tallied as teams. **Recommended for older members.**

ROOM P102: Advanced A & Basic A - Goat Session: For members not attending the Mandatory meetings in February. Class will review guidelines & project information, and answer questions.

ROOM P104: Advanced A & B and Basic A & B - Is That Really Safe?: Are you wearing the right shoes? Can that liquid harm your eyes? Class will focus on keeping animals and yourself safe on the farm.

ROOM H103: Advanced A & B & Basic A & B – Caution: Handle With Care: Class will focus on understanding the importance of the proper care and handling of your animals from start to finish.

ROOM H111: Advanced B & Basic B - Rabbit Sessions – How to Raise a Market Rabbit: For members not attending the Mandatory meetings in February & members showing Market Rabbits. Class will review guidelines & project information, and answer questions. Class will also cover raising the Market Rabbit.

ROOM H111: Advanced A & Basic A - Poultry Session: The poultry class will review basic poultry information. For members not attending the Mandatory Poultry meeting in February and members showing Market Poultry.
