Tagging day is <u>MANDATORY</u> to exhibit in the Mahoning County Junior Fair. <u>Market & Market Dairy Goats and Market/Carcass Lambs MUST BE BROUGHT to tagging</u>. <u>YOU WILL NOT BE BRINGING Market Swine TO THE TAGGING THIS YEAR</u>. If you do not see your club listed, please contact Kimberly Moff at 330-718-0444.

<u>MARKET SWINE</u>: For 2021, all members planning to exhibit Market Swine will <u>simply be picking up your tags for your</u> <u>livestock animals</u>. The committee will have the tags bagged and will have them ready for pick up. We ask that you stay in your vehicle to keep the process moving. Each member will be responsible for tagging their own animal. Families may purchase their own tagger, or clubs may purchase taggers to share within in your group. The tagger must be an Allflex tagger which can be easily ordered online or purchased at Witmer's Feed & Grain, Millstone, Heritage or possibly other local feed stores. To complete your tagging requirement, you will be responsible for completing the Market Swine ID form to include the **front**, **left side and right side photos of your animal(s)**, along with **an head/ear photo showing the <u>tag in the ear</u> to <u>mcjrfairphotos@gmail.com</u> by June 15, 2021. Photos <u>must be</u> identified by youth name and tag numbers. All animals tagged should be photographed and submitted but the deadline listed or they will be unable to exhibit in the 2021 Junior Fair Show.** 

MARKET SWINE VACCINE: For 2021, the erysipelas vaccine will be mandatory per the fair veterinarian. If your breeder vaccinated your pigs, please bring a copy of proof of vaccination to tagging. Vaccines will be donated by Lisbon Vet Clinic. The Market Livestock Committee will have the donated vaccinations available when you pick up your tags.

<u>MARKET/CARCASS LAMBS - IMPORTANT</u>: We will be weighing during tagging. We ask that you know which animals you would like to designate as Market or Carcass when you come to tagging and have this marked on an index card along with each animal's scrapie ID number.

<u>MARKET & MARKET DAIRY GOAT:</u> Please mark scrapie ID on an index card and have this ready at tagging. All wethers must be banded or castrated at the time of tagging.

The following list is the schedule for the 2021 Market Livestock Tagging Day. TRAFFICE FLOW: On May 15, Market Swine, Goats and Sheep exhibitors will enter GATE 5 ONLY off of Route 46. Take a direct right to drive by the Education Building. Take a left on Canfield Drive and continue between the Colonial Inn and Canfield Fair Office. Take a left to drive by maintenance. Market Swine Committee will be located on the right. Exhibitors taking Market Swine will stop and pick of swine tags and vaccinations from committee. If only taking Market Swine, follow straight to exit Gate #5. Market Goat & Market Lamb exhibitors will stay to the right after passing the Market Swine Committee and will drive into the North Coliseum and then exit Gate 5. Please be courteous and cautious as you exit the Coliseum. Arrive during the time you are scheduled.
